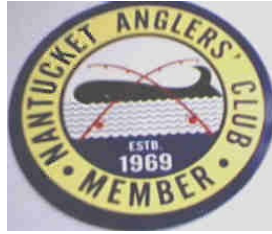


NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – AUGUST / SEPTEMBER 2004

N.A.C. 3RD ANNUAL SHARK TOURNAMENT

Saturday & Sunday, August 28 & 29, 2004

The Captain's meeting will be held on Friday the 27th at 5:30 p.m. at the Club. Entry fee is \$500.00 per entrant and 4 anglers including meal tickets for Saturday's dinner. Extra anglers are \$25.00 per person. IGFA rules apply. One shark per boat may be brought to dock per day. Lines in at 6:00 a.m. and out at 3:30 p.m. Scoring: One point per pound will be awarded for a shark 300 lbs. or greater. Exception – Mako, Thresher and Porbeagle 150 lb. minimum. Applications are available at the Club.

NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB STRIPED BASS BOAT CLASSIC 2004

Sept. 2, 2004 to Sept. 12, 2004

Fishing begins at 12:01 a.m. on the 2nd and scales close at 3:00 p.m. on the 12th. This is an individual angler boat-only Bass Tournament. Each angler may weigh-in a total of 4 fish during event. There is no bumping of fish. Combined weight of angler's fish will determine the overall winner within angler's division. Entrants may sign up at the Club anytime after Aug. 1, 2004. Anyone signing up on Sept. 2nd or later may only weigh in fish after 48 hours. Entry fee is \$50.00 per angler. Juniors may enter at no charge with written permission from parent or guardian. Prizes and divisions: Male, Female and junior. Male and Female will award the following: 1st - \$1,000.00, 2nd - \$500.00, 3rd – Trophy. Juniors – 1st - \$100.00 NAC certificate and trophy, 2nd - \$50.00 certificate and trophy, 3rd – tournament hat and shirt. All anglers will compete for largest fish trophy and largest fly rod fish trophy.
