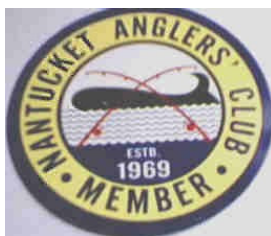


# NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – DECEMBER
