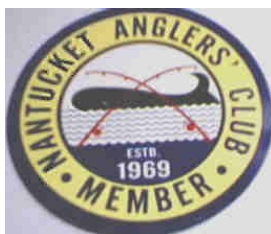


NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – NOVEMBER

Since the annual Lema-Machado fish in was cancelled due to inclement weather, we are having a one day pond tournament, the annual junior fishing awards, games, fun and dinner.

Fishing begins at 8:00 a.m. You may fish anywhere you want. The Scales close at 3:00 p.m. at the Club. Points – 1 per oz. for Pickerel, 2 per oz. for White Perch and Crappie, 3 per oz. for Yellow Perch, and 4 per oz. for Sunfish. Only the two heaviest of each species will count toward total points. Boats are allowed. State size regulations must be followed. 15” minimum for pickerel, and an 8” minimum for White Perch. After the scales close, we will have games, awards, and dinner for your family at the Club.
