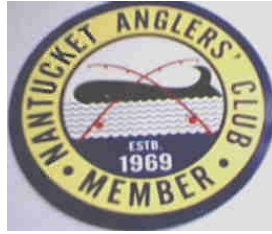


# NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – OCTOBER

The 10-day Boat Striped Bass Classic went very well. Top honors for male and female went to Bob Virta and Susan Thurston. Bob had a total score of 74.9375, and Susan had a total of 66.7875. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for men were Josh Eldridge (72.375) and Roland Nelthrop (67.2375). Women's 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> went to Jen Cusson (66.2875) and Julie Reinemo (65.725). The largest Bass caught was 22 # 8.4 oz. by Tammy King. For the juniors, 7 total anglers fished and the top 3 were Kyle Perry, Tiffany Balling and Makalia King. Congratulations to all and thanks to the Committee for making it all happen. The Club's Bluefish Challenge saw less attendance than usual but that could have been because of the weather forecast. All who did fish on Saturday were lucky to make it back alive. The weather was unbelievable. No one dared go back out on Sunday. Rumor has it they are all taking up golf. ### KATHY KELLIHER FALL POND TOURNAMENT OCTOBER 2-3, 2004

12:01 a.m. Saturday to 6:00 p.m. Sunday. Teams must be signed up by 8:00 p.m. on Friday. \$40.00 per team. Women only. Fish must be weighed in within 12 hours of being caught. This is a beach or boat tournament. Points – Pickerel – 1 per oz., White Perch and Crappie – 2 per oz., Yellow Perch – 3 per oz., and Sunfish – 4 per oz. 3 places will be paid out. There is a two-rod maximum and either team member may weigh in fish. Pickerel must be a minimum of 15 inches and White Perch must be 8 inches.
