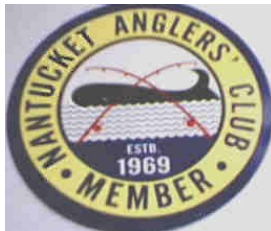


# NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – SEPTEMBER 2005

## FALL BOAT BLUEFISH CHALLENGE

Sept. 10 & 11, 2005

\$40.00 per angler – Please register by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, the 9<sup>th</sup>. IGFA rules plus wire or lead line allowed. Heaviest two fish may be counted. Lines in 12:01 a.m. Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> and lines out at 3:00 p.m. Sept. 11<sup>th</sup>. Scales will close at 4:00 p.m. Dinner will be served at 6:00 on Saturday night, and the awards will be presented Sunday at 5:00 p.m.

## LEMA-MACHADO DAY

Pond Tournament begins at 8 a.m. and the scales will close at 3 p.m. The usual point system will be used and only two heaviest of all species will count for points. Boats are allowed. State regs: Pickerel – 15 “ minimum and 8” minimum for White Perch. The Annual Awards, Games and dinner will take place at the Club.
