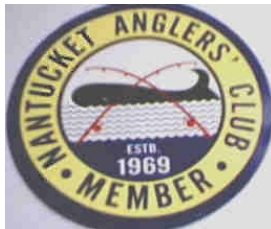


# NANTUCKET ANGLERS' CLUB NEWSLETTER – JANUARY 2005
