Fishing begins 12:01 Sept. 9 through 3:00 p.m. on Sept. 10. The Scales close at 4:00 p.m. IGFA rules plus wire or lead line is allowed. The heaviest 2 fish will be counted, and larger ones may bump previous ones. Awards will be given for: Single heaviest Bluefish - \$200.00  
1<sup>st</sup> – 50% of net entry pool  
2<sup>nd</sup> – 30% of net entry pool  
3<sup>rd</sup> - 20% of net entry pool  
20% of pool goes toward tournament expenses. Dinner will be served Sunday night at 5:30. Awards will be presented before dinner. Please sign up at the Club.
