BOTTOM FEEDERS TOURNAMENT

Saturday, July 24th or Sunday, July 25, 2004 - 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily Anglers must sign up by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, 23rd and declare the choice of fishing day. This is a boat and or beach tournament. Entry fee is \$20.00 per person. Juniors are free of charge. 1st prize will be awarded to both boat and beach.

Points – Scup – 4 per oz., Sea Robins – 3 per oz., Black Sea Bass – 2 per oz., Flounder or Fluke – 1 per oz. The two largest fish from each specie will count for total points. Fish may be bumped for larger ones. All fish must meet state size requirements. Scup – 10 inches, Fluke – 16 ½ inches, Sea Bass 12 inches. Rules and sign up sheet will be available July 17th at the Club.
