To the Membership – As we begin a new year, we have included the by-laws and house rules for a refresher to all. It is the Club's wish to have informed and active members. The newsletters every month are a way to get most information out to you. Our website is also another spot to find info about goings on at the Club. We try to keep it updated as often as possible. Some of the more common ones that we get are explained here along as in the house rules and by laws. First and foremost question – **1. When are dues due????** - Renewal forms go out in late October via email to all members. Payments are accepted beginning Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> and through December. **DUES WERE DUE!!!** As usual, all dues must be paid in full by December 31<sup>st</sup> or your membership shall be rescinded. This includes any minimum amounts unfulfilled. Don't let that be you. **2. What are the hours of operation???** – we are currently in the winter mode of the Club where we are open on weekdays at 3:00 p.m. until close. Weekends – we are open at 9:00 a.m. – In the summer season (May 1 – Oct. 31) we are open every day at 9:00 a.m. until close. **3. What hours do we serve food???** – In the winter, we only serve dinners and are offered every night from 5:30 – 8:30 p.m. Summers – we serve lunch daily from 11:30 -2:30, and dinners from 5:30 – 9:00. **No, we do not serve lunch in the winter months.** If we are, it is a special event, and will let you know in advance. **4. Have I met my minimum???** – The bartender or the server can give you an estimate on your minimum spent, or better yet, you can read the statements sent out each month. Each statement shows how much you must spend and what you have currently spent. The minimum year of spending begins on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, and goes through Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>. Please make sure you are getting credit for your account when attending the Club. Know your membership number..... **5. How many guests can I bring to the Club???** – A guest may visit the Club 12 times per year with a member. ALL GUESTS MUST BE SIGNED IN TO THE GUEST BOOK EVERY TIME -the Club must follow the guidelines of the state's liquor license policy as we have a Club license. This is a requirement put upon us by the state. It doesn't matter if it is a family member, someone just joining you for a beverage, food, or a meeting. ALL must be signed in. The server is not allowed to serve a guest unless a member is accompanying them and has signed them in. This is the rule that has been broken the most of late. **6. When is the Club moving???** – your guess is as good as mine, but one thing is certain – nothing will be decided without letting the membership have a say. **7. Why is the server or bartender weighing in a fish ahead of waiting on me???** – WE ARE FIRST AND FOREMOST A FISHING CLUB!!! SOME MEMBERS SEEM TO HAVE FORGOTTEN THIS.....yes, the food and drink helps to pay the bills, but the bottom line is..... **WE ARE A FISHING CLUB!** - so, to all members – tight lines, fish on, and literally fish on! The annual tournaments begin on January 1<sup>st</sup>....
